Committee Vote: Favorable – 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Olson, Toles, Lehman and Patterson).

The December 2010 Cycle of Amendments to the 2008 Water and Sewer Plan contains four (4) applications requesting water and/or sewer category changes.

The Committee voted favorable on the County Executive's recommendations on all four (4) category change applications: 10/W-02 Harry Blonder Property (Retain 5), 10/W-04 Pyles-Chrysler Way, LLC Property (Move to Category S3), 10/W-05 Town Houses at Marlton (Move to Category 4) and 10/M-03 Brandywine Recycling Facility (Move to Category 3).

The Committee voted favorable on CR -20-2011.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

The 2008 Water and Sewer Plan provides for three cycles of category change requests annually to amend the Plan. This Resolution represents the December 2010 Cycle of Amendments.

The 2008 Water and Sewer Plan was adopted by CR-91-2008, and amended by CR-17-2009, CR-52-2009, CR-5-2010, CR-19-2010, CR-82-2010 and CR-20-2011. The December 2010 Cycle contains four (4) requests for a category change.

Three (3) category change requests are in the Western Branch sewershed and one (1) in the Mattawoman sewershed.

Environment Article, Title 9, Subtitle 5, of the Maryland Annotated Code, sets procedures for amendments and revisions to the Plan. At least 30 days prior to the public hearing on the amendments, the County Council must submit to the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission and Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission a copy of the resolution for their recommendations.
