**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Joint Land Use Study

3 For the purpose of supporting the recommendations of the 2009 Joint Base Andrews Naval Air  
4 Facility Washington Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) and establishing the JLUS Implementation  
5 Committee.

6 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council recognizes the importance of Joint Base  
7 Andrews Naval Air Facility Washington to the local and regional economy, and thus the need to  
8 protect its operational mission and capacity; and

9 WHEREAS it is recognized that it is the responsibility of the local government to protect  
10 public health, safety, and welfare by preparing a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS); and

11 WHEREAS the JLUS Policy and Technical Committees worked together with Joint Base  
12 Andrews over the course of fourteen months to develop the JLUS; and

13 WHEREAS the JLUS contains recommendations for actions that will ensure compatible  
14 development adjacent to Joint Base Andrews; and

15 WHEREAS the Prince George's County Council supports the recommendations of the  
16 2009 *Joint Base Andrews Naval Air Facility Washington Joint Land Use Study* (JLUS), which  
17 includes a recommendation to form an implementation committee; and

18 WHEREAS the Prince George's County Council desires to create a formal committee to  
19 facilitate implementation of the JLUS recommendations;

20 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for  
21 designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the county who shall  
22 assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

1           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Prince George's County Council does  
 2 hereby establish the JLUS Implementation Committee for a period of five years and assign it the  
 3 responsibility of providing oversight, direction, and assistance in obtaining resources needed to  
 4 implement the recommendations of the 2009 *Joint Base Andrews Naval Air Facility Washington*  
 5 *JLUS*; and

6           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the JLUS Implementation Committee shall be  
 7 composed of fifteen (15) members to include local, state, and federal elected and/or appointed  
 8 officials and representatives from the following:

- 9           1) Two representatives of the Prince George's County Council;
- 10          2) A representative of the Office of the County Executive;
- 11          3) A representative of the Prince George's County Planning Board;
- 12          4) A representative of the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation;
- 13          5) A representative of the United States Department of Defense;
- 14          6) A representative from the leadership of Joint Base Andrews;
- 15          7) A representative of the Maryland Department of Business & Economic  
 16             Development, Office of Military and Federal Affairs;
- 17          8) A representative of a business, trade or commercial organization;
- 18          9) A representative of the business industry;
- 19          10) A representative of the development industry;
- 20          11) A representative from a civic or community association located north of Joint Base  
 21             Andrews;
- 22          12) A representative from a civic or community association located south of Joint Base  
 23             Andrews;
- 24          13) A representative from the United States Congress;
- 25          14) A representative from the Maryland State General Assembly;

26           The Chair/Vice Chair shall be appointed by the County Council for a three year term, subject to  
 27           reappointment to one year terms of service.

28           The term of service for Committee members shall be two years, subject to reappointment to one-  
 29           year terms of service.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Prince George’s County Planning Department of  
2 The Maryland-National Park and Planning Commission will provide staff assistance to the  
3 committee; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the JLUS Implementation Committee shall provide  
5 an annual report to the Prince George’s County Council of the committee’s activities and  
6 accomplishments.
