**REPORT:**

Committee Vote: Favorable 4-0 (In favor Council Members Burroughs, Adams, Ivey, Oriadha)

The Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee met on February 26, 2026, to consider the nomination of Angela Fair as Director of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB).

The OMB is the County's central agency for budget and fiscal planning. OMB leads the development of the annual operating and capital budgets in coordination with the County Executive, analyzes revenue and expenditure projections, and provides expert fiscal guidance to County departments. The OMB also conducts performance management and policy analysis to support sound financial decision-making and ensure responsible oversight of public resources.

Ms. LaJoia Cannon, Interim Appointment Liaison, County Executive's Office, provided information regarding Ms. Fair's educational and professional background, indicating that Ms. Fair has more than 20 years of public sector executive experience in financial management and strategic planning. She previously served as Deputy Director of Prince George's County Fire/EMS Department and as Comptroller and Budget Manager for Prince George's County Police Department, overseeing operating and grant budgets exceeding \$400 million. She also has prior experience within the Office of Management and Budget.

Ms. Cannon further shared that Ms. Fair holds a Master of Public Administration and a Bachelor of Science in Accounting, as well as executive-level leadership training that complements her extensive public-sector experience. Based on her extensive background in fiscal stewardship and public sector leadership, the County Executive expressed confidence in Ms. Fair's ability to effectively lead the OMB.

Ms. Fair also addressed the Committee, reflecting on her 24 years of service to Prince George's County and her progression from budget analyst to executive leadership roles with the Police and

Fire/EMS Departments. She reiterated her experience managing large operating and capital budgets, negotiating complex contracts, and strengthening fiscal oversight. She expressed her commitment to leading the OMB as a strategic, transparent partner focused on long-term sustainability and accountability. She highlighted her experience as Comptroller for the Police Department and later as Deputy Director for Fire/EMS, where she managed large operating and capital budgets, led complex contract negotiations, oversaw major equipment procurements, and ensured strong fiscal controls while maintaining operational readiness. Ms. Fair concluded by thanking the Committee Members for their consideration and for their continued stewardship of the County.

The Committee Members expressed strong support for Ms. Fair's appointment, commending her depth of knowledge, professionalism, and proven leadership in financial management. They highlighted their confidence in her expertise, particularly her command of budget operations and commitment to structural sustainability, and thanked her for her continued service to the County.

The Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee voted favorably 4-0 on the nomination of Ms. Angela Fair as the Director of the Office of Management and Budget.
