The Transit Development Master Plan is a five-year plan for the operation and improvement of the County's transit services. The Department of Public Works and Transportation presented the Committee with a copy of the Transit Development Master Plan and indicated that copies will be printed for all Council members. The first year of the Transit Development Master Plan involves the implementation of local bus service in several locations throughout the County. (The Council

received detailed information on this issue during the review of the Department of Public Works and Transportation's FY 97 budget.) George Cardwell of the Transportation and Public Facilities Planning Division (M-NCPPC) provided the Committee with a copy of the Mobility Match Study, which provided the basis for the implementation of local bus service in the Hyattsville and Clinton/Marlow Heights areas as well as a subsidized shared-ride taxi service in the Capitol Heights/Seat Pleasant District Heights area.
