2008 Legislative Session Resolution No. CR-8-2008 Proposed by The Chairman (by request – County Executive) Introduced by Council Members Dernoga and Turner Co-Sponsors Date of Introduction ___ February 19, 2008 RESOLUTION A RESOLUTION concerning Financial assistance to Comcast of Maryland, Inc. from the Maryland Economic Development Assistance Fund and from Prince George's County, Maryland For the purpose of endorsing a \$500,000 and \$50,000 loan to Comcast of Maryland, Inc. ("Comcast") from the Maryland Economic Development Assistance Fund ("MEDAF") and Prince George's County, Maryland (the "County"), respectively, for costs associated with leasing office space for operation of a service center in the County. WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 5-1402 through 5-1412 of Article 83A of the Maryland Annotated Code (the "Act"), MEDAF is established within the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development (the "Department") for the purpose of expanding employment opportunities in Maryland by providing financial assistance to businesses that are engaged in eligible industry sectors; and WHEREAS, Comcast seeks to operate a new advanced service center in Largo, Maryland by leasing approximately 80,000 square feet of office space at 1301 McCormick Drive ("Project") for a term of ten (10) years; and WHEREAS, Comcast estimates that the Project's costs will total at least \$4,000,000 comprising costs for tenant improvements, furniture, fixtures, and equipment and Comcast expects to create at least 500 permanent full-time employment positions at the Project site by December 31, 2010; and WHEREAS, on October 3, 2007, the Department and Comcast entered into a proposed letter for a loan of \$500,000 from MEDAF to Comcast (the "MEDAF Loan"); and

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WHEREAS, the proceeds of the MEDAF Loan will be used to reimburse Comcast for

eligible project costs under the MEDAF program, including construction of leasehold improvements and acquisition and installation of furniture, fixtures and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the term of the MEDAF Loan is proposed to be from disbursement through March 31, 2014 at an annual rate of three percent (3%) with all principal and accrued interest deferred over the term of the loan; and

WHEREAS, in the event that Comcast (i) expends at least \$4,000,000 in eligible project costs at the Project site by December 31, 2009; (ii) employs at least 500 full-time employees at the Project site from December 31, 2010 through December 31, 2013; and (iii) otherwise complies with the obligations of the MEDAF Loan, all outstanding deferred principal and accrued interest is eligible to be forgiven at the end of the term; and

WHEREAS, part of the Project costs will be financed by a loan of \$50,000 to Comcast from the County Incentive Leverage Fund, managed by the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation ("County Loan"); and

WHEREAS, the County Loan shows the County's support for the Project by financing a portion of the Project costs equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the MEDAF Loan, as required by Section 5-1405(f)(2)(ii) of the Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 5-1405(f)(1) of the Act requires a formal resolution of the governing body of the County endorsing the MEDAF Loan; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive endorses the MEDAF Loan and the County Loan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the recitals to this resolution are hereby incorporated herein by reference and deemed a substantive part of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the MEDAF Loan of \$500,000 and the County Loan of \$50,000 to Comcast, are hereby endorsed by the County Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective as of the date of its adoption.
