BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Compensation of Elected Officials

3 For the purpose of amending the provisions of the method of setting the compensation of the
4 County Executive and Members of the County Council to prevent the increase in compensation
5 levels in any fiscal year in which there is no increase in the base compensation level of General
6 Schedule employees.

7 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

8 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

9 Sections 2-110.01 and 2-112.01,
10 The Prince George's County Code
11 (2007 Edition, 2008 Supplement).

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
13 Maryland, that Sections 2-110.01 and 2-112.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and the
14 same are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

15 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

16 DIVISION 1. COUNTY COUNCIL.

17 **Sec. 2-110.01. Compensation.**

18 [(a) The members of the County Council shall receive compensation for the performance of
19 their public duties under the Charter of \$70,000 per annum, beginning on the first Monday in
20 December, 2002, and adjusted annually thereafter on the first Monday in December by a
21 percentage which is seventy-five percent of the percentage by which the Consumer Price Index

1 for the Washington Metropolitan area as of July 31 shall have changed from the preceding July
2 31st.] (b) The compensation of the Chairman of the County Council shall be fixed at \$5,000 per
3 annum in excess of the salary of the other council members during such person's term as
4 Chairman, and the compensation of the Vice Chairman of the County Council shall be fixed at
5 \$2,500 per annum in excess of the compensation of the other Council members during such
6 person's term as Vice Chairman.

7 [(b)] (a) The compensation of members of the County Council, beginning on the first
8 Monday in December, 2006, shall be determined in accordance with Section 308 of the Charter
9 [and Section 2-105 of the County Code] provided however that if no increase in the base
10 compensation levels contained in the salary schedule for general schedule employees has been
11 approved for any fiscal year, the compensation shall not be adjusted during that same fiscal year.

12 **SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.**

13 **DIVISION 2. COUNTY EXECUTIVE.**

14 **Sec. 2-112.01. Compensation.**

15 (a) [The County Executive shall receive compensation for the performance of his public
16 duties under the Charter of \$130,000 per annum, beginning on the first Monday in December,
17 2002, and adjusted annually thereafter on the first Monday in December by a percentage which is
18 seventy-five percent of the percentage by which the Consumer Price Index for the Washington
19 Metropolitan area as of August 31, shall have changed from the preceding August 31st.

20 (b)] The compensation of the County Executive, beginning on the first Monday in
21 December, 2006, shall be determined in accordance with Section 406 of the Charter [and Section
22 2-105 of the County Code] provided however that if no increase in the base compensation levels
23 contained in the salary schedule for general schedule employees has been approved for any fiscal
24 year, the compensation shall not be adjusted during that same fiscal year .

1 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
2 calendar days after it becomes law.
