Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Del Giudice, Maloney and Scott).

This Resolution will amend the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule "F-O" for eight (8) Fire Officials and implement similar economic modifications contained in the Collective Bargaining Agreement for Fire Fighters through the rank of Battalion Chief. The provisions of CB-62-1995 are not included in this Resolution.

## Highlights of the FY96 Salary Plan

- 1. A Salary Schedule (pp 5)
- 2. No Merit or COLA increase (pp 6)
- 3. An increase in employee pension contribution rate by 3% from 1% to 4%. (pp 8 IX) (The County's contribution to the plan is 16%)
- 4. Elimination of the clothing allowance of \$825 (pp 9 XI)
- 5. Elimination of the physical training supplement in the amount of \$225 (pp 9 XII)
- 6. Increase in accidental death insurance from \$5,000 to \$50,000 (pp 10 XVI)

The fiscal impact on the County will be positive in the amount of approximately \$46,844. This amount is related to cost savings from the (1) elimination of the merit increases, (2) increased employee pension contributions, (3) elimination of the clothing allowance, and (4) elimination of the physical training supplement.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

The County Council adopted CB-41-1995 and CR-30-1995 implementing the provisions of the negotiated collective bargaining agreement for Fire Fighters through the rank of Battalion Chief. This resolution will enact similar provisions for Fire Officials. The estimated fiscal impact will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
