CB-96-2014 adopts the 2014 Prince Georges County Storm-Water Management Design Manual pursuant to the County Stormwater Management Ordinance adopted by CB-15-2011.

Susan Hubbard and Mary Giles of the Department of the Permits, Inspections and Enforcement for Prince Georges County, provided an overview, additional information and responded to questions from the Committee.

Staff oriented the Committee along with all legislative comments.

The Office of Law finds the CB-96-2014 is in proper legislative form and saw no legal impediments to its adoption.

This Resolution is for the purpose of adopting the 2014 Prince George's County Stormwater Management Design Manual (the "Manual"). The Manual was last updated in August of 2001. The 2014 Manual will be used as a comprehensive guide for permit applicants and their consultant teams in the design of stormwater management systems, pursuant to the goals set forth in the County's Water Quality Resources and Grading Code, found in Subtitle 32 of the County Code. The 2014 Manual updates stormwater treatment and conveyance policies and stormwater design parameters, pursuant to the State laws and regulations, including the Stormwater Management Act of 2007.
