AN ACT concerning

Maintenance of County-owned property

FOR the purpose of requiring that County-owned property be
maintained free of weeds greater than twelve inches in height.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 14. Morals and Conduct.

Section 14-121,

The Prince George's County Code (1987 Edition, 1989 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 14-121 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 14. MORALS AND CONDUCT.

DIVISION 3. ANTI-LITTER AND WEED ORDINANCE.

Sec. 14-212. Weed height.

(a) It shall be the duty of every person as owner, occupant, lessee or agent in charge of land lying in any subdivision within

the unincorporated areas of the County, except as otherwise provided in Section 14-119, to keep all weeds, as defined, cut to a height of not over twelve (12) inches on lots of one (1) acre or less; provided, however, that when a parcel of land, whether subdivided or not, is contiguous to a developed lot, plot, site or tract, of one (1) acre or less then, and in such event, the provisions hereof shall apply for a distance of fifty (50) feet equidistant from the common boundary line. For all real property owned by the County, regardless of size, all weeds, as defined, shall be cut to a height of not over twelve (12) inches.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
