PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 4/16/97

This resolution will amend the FY97-2002 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) by changing the description of the Branchville Fire Station #11 capital project.

The project description for Branchville Fire Station #11 (LK510853) on page 382 of the Capital Improvement Program describes the project as a replacement to an existing fire station. It is deemed to be in the best public interest to renovate and provide an addition to the current fire station instead of constructing a replacement fire station.

The County Executive has recommended that the County Council change the project description for the Branchville Fire Station #11. The renovations and additions to the existing station will provide improvements to the bunk-room, enlarge the engine bays and renovate office and meeting rooms.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-25-1997, since the appropriation level will remain the same.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This resolution amends the project description for Branchville Fire Station #11, a capital project included in the FY 1997-2002 Capital Improvement Program. The Branchville Fire Station capital project is to consist of a renovation and addition rather than a replacement station as currently described in the capital improvement program document. The new description conforms to the updated scope of the project.
