BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Dine-in Restaurant Permitting Incentive Act of 2026

3 For the purpose of providing for a reduction in permitting fees for sit-down restaurants to
4 stimulate restaurant growth in Prince George’s County; and generally relating to permitting fees.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

7 Section 2-253.63

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 2-253.63 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
12 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

14 DIVISION 14C. FEES AND CHARGES.

17 (j) Sit-down Restaurant Permitting Incentive Program.

18 (1) Definition. For the purposes of this subsection, **Sit-down restaurant** means a
19 restaurant, as defined pursuant to Part 27-5 of Subtitle 27 of the Code, whose principal method of
20 operation consists of sit-down table service provided by dedicated waitstaff for on-site food and
21 beverage consumption. Restaurants whose principal method of operation is counter service,

1 quick service, or carryout food and beverage service for offsite consumption are not sit-down
2 restaurants under this Subsection. Restaurants that provide drive through service are not sit-down
3 restaurants under this Subsection.

4 (2) Sit-down Restaurant Permitting Incentive. Fees and charges pursuant to this section
5 assessed to a business that is a sit-down restaurant or to an applicant to operate as a sit-down
6 restaurant shall be discounted by fifty percent (50%) at the time of such assessment.

7 (3) The Director of the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement:
8 (A) shall interpret this Section and assess the features of a business applicant to
9 determine whether the business is a sit-down restaurant in accordance with this Subsection
10 before applying the discount prescribed herein; and

11 (B) is authorized to promulgate regulations to administer this Act, subject to approval
12 by resolution of the County Council.

13 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
14 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
15 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
16 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
17 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
18 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
19 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
20 or section.

21 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
22 calendar days after it becomes law.
