Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Knotts, Campos, Dean, Exum and Turner.)

This resolution will amend the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule W for Deputy Sheriffs through the rank of Lieutenant in the Office of the Sheriff and reflects the modifications to the two-year collective bargaining agreement (FY2008 – FY2009).

The Office of Law has reviewed this resolution and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The summary of the Salary Plan and the fiscal impact are included in CB-40-2008.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This is companion legislation to the bill to approve the collective bargaining agreement between Prince George's County, Maryland and the Deputy Sheriff's Association of Prince George's County, Inc. for Fiscal Years 2008 and 2009. This resolution also reflects modifications to the agreement. A fiscal impact statement will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.

The proposed salary plan amendments were submitted to the County Council by the County Executive on May 16, 2008. Pursuant to Section 903 of the Charter, if the Council fails to take final action on the proposed salary plan before July 15, 2008, the salary plan shall stand approved.
