### BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed legislation will provide for the licensing and regulation of adult entertainment business, managers of such businesses, and entertainers. Currently there are no regulations pertaining to adult entertainment businesses and employees. The proposed legislation will provide for the definition and licensing of adult entertainment business and employees and provide civil penalties for violations. Entertainers will be required to maintain a minimal distance from patrons while performing in certain states of undress.
