Committee Vote: Favorable as Amended, 3-0 (In favor: Council Members Harrington, Bland and Exum)

Staff provided a summary of the bill. CB-81-2006 amends provisions of the Code relating to parking regulations and amends the hours commercial vehicles may be parked on County streets or highways.

The Sponsor, Council Member Knotts presented his position and support for CB-81-2006 and asked for favorable consideration by the Committee on this legislation. Mr. Knotts also asked the Committee to increase the current fine from One Hundred and fifty Dollars (\$150.00) to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to conform to State Law. The Committee Chair, David Harrington requested that Revenue Authority be removed from the Bill.

The Office of Audits and Investigations determined that CB-81-2006 would enhance the County revenues.

The proposed legislation would amend the provisions of the County Code relating to parking regulations by amending the hours commercial vehicles may be parked on County streets or highways. The legislation would delete the current language that restricts any commercial vehicle from parking on any County street or highway between the hours of 6 p.m. and 6 a.m each day of the week or at any time on Sundays or holidays.
