PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 7/3/96

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Bailey, Del Giudice, Maloney and Scott).

This bill will enable the County to borrow in an amount not exceeding \$2,823,000 to finance the Capital Projects for the Prince George's Community College Facilities and for the issuance of bonds.

The following projects are in the County's capital program for FY1997-2002:

(1) Major System Replacement

- (2) Science Building
- (3) Lanham Hall and Bladen Science Wing

The Council's approval of this bill will allow it to be placed on the fall ballot for voter consideration. Since referenda only occur biannually at the General Election, voter approval is necessary one to two years before project funding.

There will be no fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-40-1996. (However, a negative fiscal impact, to the extent of the debt service obligation incurred by the County when the bonds are sold, will be associated with the enactment of the legislation which authorizes and empowers the County to issue and sell the bonds. The amount of negative fiscal impact cannot be estimated at this time due to the uncertainty of future events).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This bill will authorize Prince George's County, Maryland, to borrow money to finance the design, construction, relocation, rehabilitation, or repair of Community College Facilities.
