AN ACT concerning

The Classification Plan for Prince George's County
FOR the purpose of adding new classes of work, abolishing certain
classes of work, changing titles for certain classes of work and
assigning certain existing and new classes of work to the bargaining
units represented by the Police Civilian Employees Association.

WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the
Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16
of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order to provide better
governmental services, recommended to the County Council amendments
to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect
to certain classes of work described within Sections 1 and 2 of this
bill; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive,
pursuant to Section 903 of the Pr
ince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of
the Prince George's County Code, has recommended to the County

Council amendments to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County with respect to certain classes of work described within Section 1 of this bill, in order to implement fully recommendations of an organizational study of certain civilian positions in the Police Department and in anticipation (following the joint petition by the County and the PCEA) of the issuance by the Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board of a Clarification of Unit - Amendment of Certifications Nos. 73-PG-R-8 and 73-PG-R-9 (as amended) to include in the bargaining unit represented by the PCEA certain classes of work listed in Section 1 of this bill; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby amended as follows:
