Fiscal Policy and Government Operations
Committee Report

Date: October 30, 1991

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 3-0-2 (In favor: Council Members Del Giudice, MacKinnon and Mills; Abstained: Council Members Wineland and Fletcher)

Unlike other contracts with other previously existing bargaining groups, the Crossing Guards did not already have a contract in place covering FY92. The Crossing Guards will receive the same cost of living adjustments and merit increase provisions in FY92-93 as the County's General Schedule employees.

The Legislative Officer and the Office of Law have reviewed this legislation and find it to be in proper legislative form.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This bill is to approve and adopt the referenced collective bargaining agreement in accordance with Section 16-233(e) of the Personnel Law. The County and Council 67, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 241 (School Crossing Guards) have completed labor negotiations for a new collective bargaining agreement covering fiscal years 1992 and 1993. The fiscal impact of this agreement will be provided by the Office of Management and Budget.
