Subtitle 5 of Title 2 (Agriculture) of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides for the establishment of the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation and a procedure for the formation of agricultural districts. This petition is the fifth to be filed in Prince George's County since the inception of the program. To date, no districts have been established in Prince George's County. The County governing body must decide whether to recommend that the Foundation approve the district.
