BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

On July 1, 1996, a school facility surcharge will be imposed on new residential development, pursuant to CB-83-1995. State law does not permit an adequate public facilities test for schools to be applied in conjunction with the surcharge. However, for planning purposes, there is a need to conduct such a test. This resolution directs the Planning Board to conduct a School Planning Capacity Analysis on all new residential subdivisions, in order to monitor the impact of new development on school facilities and to aid in the planning of new facilities.
