For the purpose of initiating an amendment to the 1989/1990 Approved Master Plan for Langley				
Park-College Park-Greenbelt and Vicinity, and Adopted Sectional Map Amendment for Planning				
Areas 65, 66 and 67, 2001 Approved Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for the				
Greenbelt Metro Area, and 2002 Approved College Park US 1 Corridor Sector Plan and				
Sectional Map Amendment (Portion of Planning Area 66), and approving the Goals, Concepts,				
Guidelines, and Public Participation Program in order to develop a comprehensive approach to				
implement the recommendations of the 2002 General Plan, to ensure that future development is				
consistent with C	ounty policies.			
WHEREAS	the current Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for the College			
Park/US 1 Corridor (Portion of Planning Area 66), was approved in April 2002; and				
WHEREAS	WHEREAS, the current Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) for additional			
properties to be included in the amendment (Portion of Planning Area 66), were approved in				
October 1989 and May 1990 respectively; and				
WHERE	S, the current Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for properties			
located in the Hollywood community (Portion of Planning Area 66), was approved in October,				
2001; and				
WHEREAS, Sections 27-225.01 and 27-641 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's				

County establish procedures whereby the Prince George's County Planning Board may initiate a

Master Plan Amendment and a concurrent SMA with the approval of the District Council; and WHEREAS, the approved Fiscal Year 2009 Planning Department Work Program requires that a sector plan be prepared for the Central US 1 Corridor area generally located within and adjacent to the City of College Park; and

WHEREAS, the Sector Plan area being part of Planning Area 66 is generally comprised of the properties bounded by the city boundaries of College Park to the north, the southern limit of mixed-use properties south of Guilford Road to the south, and commercial, mixed-use, vacant and related properties fronting or oriented to US 1 to the east and west, including established residential areas along Guilford Drive, Knox Road, and Cherry Hill Road, and commercial and residential properties located in the Hollywood community at the intersection of Rhode Island Avenue and Edgewood Road and all properties inclusive of 47th Place West between Lackawanna Street and 48th Place (as shown in Attachment A); and

WHEREAS, the Goals, Concepts, Guidelines, and Public Participation Program (Attachment B) establish the purpose, the issues to be addressed during the plan preparation, and methodology for ensuring adequate community involvement in the planning process; and

WHEREAS, the Sector Plan will establish policies and strategies to guide the future growth and development of the Central US 1 Corridor at an intensity appropriate for the Developed and Developing Tiers and designated Corridors, as articulated in the 2002 *Prince George's County Approved General Plan*; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the District Council to process the Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment concurrently, in accordance with Section 27-225.01.05 of the Zoning Ordinance, to shorten the process and provide a strong interrelationship between the Sector Plan and zoning of land as a tool to implement land use recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a Sector Plan and a concurrent Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) for the Central US 1 Corridor in accordance with the requirements of Parts 3 and 13 of the Zoning Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Council has considered and hereby approves the Goals, Concepts, Guidelines, and Public Participation Program (Attachment B).
