8	(5) Standard Letters of Exemption											
9	(A) A Standard Letter of Exemption shall be issued when a lot or parcel or											
0	combination of lots and parcels is less than 40,000 square feet in area.											
1	(B) A Standard Letter of Exemption shall be issued when a lot or parcel or											
2	combination of lots and parcels of any size has less than 20,000 square feet of woodland and is											
3	not subject to a previously approved TCP. If a lot or parcel that was determined to be exempt											
4	using this provision becomes reforested to the point where more than 20,000 square feet of											
5	woodlands exist prior to issuance of a grading permit, the exemption may be revoked by the											
6	Planning Director or their designee.											
7	[(B)] (C) A Standard Letter of Exemption is not required to be issued when the											
8	proposed activities are within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area because activities within the											
9	Critical Area are subject to Subtitle 5B. If a portion of a property is outside the Critical Area, that											
20	portion of the property shall be evaluated for conformance with this Division.											
21	[(C)] (D) A Standard Letter of Exemption shall be issued for any property that											
22	will be reviewed by the State of Maryland Department of Natural Resources. These properties											
23	include, but are not limited to land owned by the State of Maryland. A letter from the State of											
24	Maryland Department of Natural Resources stating that they are taking jurisdiction over the											
25	review of a project shall be provided with any application package. The Standard Letter of											
26	Exemption and the state approved Forest Conservation Plan shall accompany all local DRD											
27	applications and grading permit applications.											
28	[(D)] (E) A Standard Letter of Exemption may be issued when local government											
29	projects utilizing state funds are proposed and a letter from the State of Maryland Department of											
30	Natural Resources is provided stating that they will be reviewing the project.											
31	[(E)] (F) A Standard Letter of Exemption may be issued when a proposal is											

1	submitted that shows the minimum cutting or clearing of trees or woodlands necessary in										
2	compliance with the requirements of 14 C.F.R. § 77.25 relating to objects affecting navigable										
3	airspace, provided that the Federal Aviation Administration has determined that the trees are a										
4	hazard to aviation.
