**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT
(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

The Health, Education and Human Services Committee received a verbal report on November 8, 1995 regarding the status of United Communities Against Poverty (UCAP), the County's Community Action Agency (CAA). Committee members expressed concern over the lack of full Board representation or participation. Committee Members viewed the completion of the Board's membership complement as a priority in light of the number of vacant positions. Committee

directed staff to prepare a resolution reaffirming the designation of UCAP as the County's Community Action Agency, and specifying reevaluation of the CAA within one year with the primary evaluation standard of maintaining an effective and fully functioning Board. Resolution is to include Board representation, Liaison from the County Council staff and certain evaluation criteria.

Committee voted favorably 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Russell, Bailey, Scott and Wilson) to support recommendation to full Council and to the County Executive the designation of United Communities Against Poverty as the Community Action Agency (CAA) for Prince George's County with reevaluation of this designation in one year.
