**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Taxicab Service Task Force

3 For the purpose of amending the composition of the Taxicab Service Task Force.

4 WHEREAS, Prince George's County Council adopted CR-74-2009, establishing the  
5 Taxicab Service Task Force to review and evaluate the County's taxicab operations and their  
6 impact upon County residents, agencies and the industry and to recommend appropriate  
7 amendments to the County Code and regulations; and

8 WHEREAS, the County Council desires to include further representation on the Task Force  
9 regarding the operation of taxicab service and its impact on the residents and industry  
10 stakeholders and to consider appropriate recommendations for improvements related thereto; and

11 WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for  
12 designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall  
13 assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
15 County, Maryland, that the composition of the Taxicab Service Task Force is hereby amended to  
16 include a broader representation of interests.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Taxicab Service Task Force shall be composed of 7  
18 members as follows:

- 19 1. The Chairperson of the County Council or the Chairperson's representative, who shall
- 20 serve as the Chair of the Task Force;
- 21 2. The County Executive or his representative;
- 22 3. A member of the Prince George's Taxicab Board;

- 1 4. A representative of owners or operators of a licensed taxicab company in the County;
- 2 5. Two representatives of the Prince George's County Taxi Workers Alliance;
- 3 6. One (1) citizens of the County, with no pecuniary interest in any business related to the
- 4 industry, selected by the Chairperson of the County Council.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Environmental  
 6 Resources or the Director's representative and a representative from the County Police  
 7 Department shall serve as ex-officio non-voting members of the Task Force; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Taxicab Service Task Force shall present its  
 9 evaluation and recommendations to the County Council on or before March 1, 2010.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate  
 11 technical and administrative support staff to assist the Taxicab Service Task Force in its work.
