WHEREAS	S, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for
designated period	ds, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall
assist in the cons	ideration of County policies and programs.
NOW, THE	EREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
County, Marylan	d, that the composition of the Taxicab Service Task Force is hereby amended to
include a broade	representation of interests.
BE IT FUR	THER RESOLVED that the Taxicab Service Task Force shall be composed of 7
members as follo	ows:
1. The Ch	nairperson of the County Council or the Chairperson's representative, who shall

3. A member of the Prince George's Taxicab Board;

serve as the Chair of the Task Force;

- 4. A representative of owners or operators of a licensed taxicab company in the County;
- 5. Two representatives of the Prince George's County Taxi Workers Alliance;
- 6. One (1) citizens of the County, with no pecuniary interest in any business related to the industry, selected by the Chairperson of the County Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Department of Environmental Resources or the Director's representative and a representative from the County Police Department shall serve as ex-officio non-voting members of the Task Force; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Taxicab Service Task Force shall present its evaluation and recommendations to the County Council on or before March 1, 2010.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate technical and administrative support staff to assist the Taxicab Service Task Force in its work. Adopted this 1st day of December, 2009.
