For the purpose of establishing spending control limits on the Fiscal Year 2010 Water and Sewer				
Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC).				
WHEREAS, during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and				
Prince George's County Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend				
changes that would control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close				
to the level of inflation; and				
WHEREAS, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of				
a spending affordability process; and				
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's				
report through the adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery Council endorsed part				
of the report's recommendations through Resolution #12-1558; and				
WHEREAS, th	ne Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group			
Report spending affordability process; and				
WHEREAS, b	oth Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process			
beginning with the formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and				
WHEREAS, th	ne Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the			
Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make				
certain recommenda	ations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2010 Operating and Capital Budgets; and			

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery Council have

reviewed the information complied by the staff related to spending control limits on the percentage of water and sewer increases; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council recommends that WSSC, in conjunction with its Fiscal Year 2010 Budget transmittal, identify priority items that would not be funded within the approved Fiscal Year 2010 spending control limits. These items can be considered for funding at the May 2009 Bi-County meeting; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2010 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission:
