**PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT**      Date: 6/19/00

Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Wilson, Maloney and Scott).

This bill will provide for a tax credit for a single parcel of real property owned by the Beltsville/Adelphi Boys and Girls Club.

The 2000 session of the General Assembly authorized the County to enact a tax credit for real property owned by certain Boys and Girls Clubs chartered by the Prince George's Boys and Girls Club, Inc.

There will be a negative fiscal impact on the County in the amount of approximately \$863 for FY2000-01 as a result of enacting CB-42-2000. The negative fiscal impact on future years will

be determined by the assessed value of the property and the tax rates in effect for the given tax year. Any additional real property purchased by the Boys and Girls Club could result in a negative fiscal impact.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

As a result of the enactment of Chapter 460, 1999 Laws of Maryland, the County was authorized to enact a tax credit for real property owned by certain Boys and Girls Club chartered by the Prince George's County Boys and Girls Club, Incorporated. The proposed legislation would extend the tax credit in accordance with the authorizing legislation.
