BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Officer of the County Council shall prepare and certify the above questions to the local board of elections in accordance with the provisions of Section 7-103 (b) of the Election Law Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any petition for Charter Amendment or for referendum is hereafter filed that meets all requirements of law, the Legislative Officer is hereby directed to prepare and certify said question to the local board of elections in accordance with the provisions of Section 7-103 (b) of the Election Law Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event the petition reflected in Question H above fails to meet all requirements of law and is not placed on the ballot Questions F, G, H, and I, as designated above, are to be removed from the ballot for the November 2004 general election as they become abrogated by their terms or by operation of law, and Question J above shall be redesignated as Question F.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors of Elections for Prince George's County by the Clerk of the Council.
