RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Neighborhood Partnership Program - 1998 Applications

3 For the purpose of approving proposals submitted to the Secretary of the Maryland Department
4 of Housing and Community Development for approval of the proposed project and allocation of
5 tax credits under the Neighborhood Partnership Program.

6 WHEREAS, the General Assembly established at Article 83B, Sections 4-701, et. seq. the
7 Neighborhood Partnership Program to assist nonprofit organizations in carrying out approved
8 projects in designated revitalization areas, to encourage businesses to invest in designated
9 revitalization areas, and to strengthen public-private partnerships; and

10 WHEREAS, eligible nonprofit organizations may apply to the Maryland Department of
11 Housing and Community Development for approval of a project and an allocation of tax credits
12 in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per project for business entities that contribute to the project;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, two proposed projects and requests for allocations of tax credits for 1998 have
15 been submitted to the County Council for approval; and

16 WHEREAS, Strategic Consolidated Services, Inc., 4508 Suitland Road, Suitland,
17 Maryland, has requested a tax credit allocation of \$50,000 to serve a project in the Suitland area
18 and the County Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

19 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County branch Young Men Christian Association of
20 Metropolitan Washington (YMCA), 6311 Pennsylvania Avenue, Forestville, Maryland has
21 requested a tax credit allocation of \$10,000 to serve a project in the Suitland area and the County
22 Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

1 WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed that each of the applications for approval
2 and allocation submitted be approved.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
4 County, Maryland, that each of the two applications for approval of the project and allocation of
5 tax credits for 1998 be and the same are hereby approved.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council shall transmit a certified copy
7 of this resolution to the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Housing and Community
8 Development as soon as possible.
