RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Neighborhood Partnership Program - 1998 Applications

For the purpose of approving proposals submitted to the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for approval of the proposed project and allocation of tax credits under the Neighborhood Partnership Program.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly established at Article 83B, Sections 4-701, et. seq. the Neighborhood Partnership Program to assist nonprofit organizations in carrying out approved projects in designated revitalization areas, to encourage businesses to invest in designated revitalization areas, and to strengthen public-private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, eligible nonprofit organizations may apply to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for approval of a project and an allocation of tax credits in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per project for business entities that contribute to the project; and

WHEREAS, two proposed projects and requests for allocations of tax credits for 1998 have been submitted to the County Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, Strategic Consolidated Services, Inc., 4508 Suitland Road, Suitland, Maryland, has requested a tax credit allocation of \$50,000 to serve a project in the Suitland area and the County Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County branch Young Men Christian Association of Metropolitan Washington (YMCA), 6311 Pennsylvania Avenue, Forestville, Maryland has requested a tax credit allocation of \$10,000 to serve a project in the Suitland area and the County Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed that each of the applications for approval and allocation submitted be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that each of the two applications for approval of the project and allocation of tax credits for 1998 be and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development as soon as possible.
