For the purpose of requiring a special exception for the development of any property in the C-1/R-P-C Zone which abuts a public utility right-of-way.

BY adding:

Section 27-328.03,

The Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland,

being also

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

The Prince George's County Code

(1995 Edition).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-328.03 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is hereby added:

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

PART 4. SPECIAL EXCEPTIONS.

DIVISION 2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS.

Sec. 27-328.03 C-1/R-P-C Zoned Property.

All uses of land in the C-1/R-P-C Zone which abut a public utility right-of-way shall require the approval of a Special Exception.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after its adoption.
