BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

State enabling legislation authorizing the System Development Charge (SDC) fee provides that the two Councils shall meet annually to discuss and approve the SDC fee. The Councils met on May 13, 1999, and agreed to increase the SDC fee, providing an increase equal to the Consumer Price Index for the prior calendar year. The CPI for November, 1997, to November, 1998, increased by 1.8%. A comparison of the new SDC fees, with the CPI adjustment with the existing SDC fees and credits is provided below:
