Staff provided a summary of the resolution and referral comments that were received. CR-124-2013 concerns the purpose of expressing approval of the project submitted by Casa de Maryland, Inc. (CASA), whose mission is to improve the social, economic well-being and quality of life for the Latino and immigrant community in Maryland. This tax credit, in the amount of \$50,000, will support its Immigrant Integration Program in Prince George's and Montgomery County and the City Of Baltimore. The application is being submitted to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Department's Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

The Office of Law determined that CR-124-2013 was in proper legislative form and without legal impediments to its adoption.

The Office of Audits and Investigation indicated there will be no adverse fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-124-2013.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

CASA de Maryland, Inc. ("CASA") is a 501(c)(3) community based nonprofit organization whose mission is to improve the social, economic well-being, and quality of life for the Latino and immigrant community in Maryland. CASA is a community resource, facilitator and advocate for low-income, Latino and other immigrant community members. They provide service to the community through seven offices, two of which are located in Langley Park, Maryland. CASA is applying to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for approval of its Immigrant Integration Program (the "Project") for participation in the Community Investment Tax Credit Program. CASA is seeking tax credit allocations in the amount of \$50,000.00 to support this Project which includes citizenship education, mentoring and interview preparation, application assistance, and post-naturalization support. The State of Maryland requires local legislative support for participation in the Program.
