This emergency bill will appropriate revenue to the General Fund for costs that were not anticipated in the approved Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Budget. This emergency bill provides certain conditions and restrictions on this supplementary appropriation to ensure that the public policy priorities of the County are afforded appropriate consideration.
