RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Municipal Annexation

3 For the purpose of petitioning the chief executive and administrative officer of the City of
4 Hyattsville for referendum on a certain resolution of annexation.

5 WHEREAS, Article 23A, Section 19 of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides for
6 the annexation of land into a municipality; and

7 WHEREAS, the City of Hyattsville considered petitions for annexation into the City by
8 the residents of an area in the unincorporated area of Prince George's County adjacent to the
9 City; and

10 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hyattsville adopted Annexation Resolution
11 No. 2004-04 on July 19, 2004; and

12 WHEREAS, Article 23A, Section 19(h) provides that at any time within the 45-day
13 period following final enactment of the resolution of annexation, the governing body of the
14 county or counties in which the municipality is located, by at least a two-thirds majority vote,
15 may petition the chief executive and administrative officer of the municipal corporation for a
16 referendum on the resolution; and

17 WHEREAS, the governing body of Prince George's County, Maryland desires that the
18 question of annexation into a municipality be decided by a majority vote of the persons
19 directly affected by the proposed annexation.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
21 County, Maryland, that chief executive and administrative officer of the City of Hyattsville
22 are hereby petitioned pursuant to the provisions of Article 23A, Section 19, Annotated Code
23 of Maryland, for a referendum on Annexation Resolution No. 2004-04.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council is directed to transmit a
2 copy of this Resolution to the chief executive and administrative officer of the City of
3 Hyattsville.

4 Adopted this ____ day of _____, 2004, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds
5 of the members of the full County Council.
