WHEREA	S, there now exist electronic cigarettes, a new product used to replace traditional
cigarettes; and	
WHEREA	S, there is currently no credible research as to the safety of electronic cigarettes;
and	
WHEREA	S, the County Council recognizes the need for such research as integral to
ensuring the hea	lth, safety and welfare of the citizens of Prince George's County; and
WHEREA	S, the County Council supports a healthy and safe environment for the citizens of
Prince George's	County; and
	S, on September 15, 2013, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the
	es of Health (NIH) awarded the University of Maryland a \$19 million grant in
	a new research center entitled the "University of Maryland Tobacco Center of
Regulatory Science" which is focused on the study of a wide range of tobacco products as well	
	cotine products such as electronic cigarettes and their impact on public health;
and	
WHEREAS, the FDA's preliminary research with respect to the safety of electronic	
cigarettes is anticipated to be completed within the next 60 to 90 days; and	
	S, the result of this research shall be crucial to the County Council as it
implements legislative and policy initiatives directed at enhancing the health, safety and welfare

of the citizens of Prince George's County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council enthusiastically supports and anticipates the FDA's research on the safety of electronic cigarettes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council also enthusiastically supports and anticipates reviewing the research from the University of Maryland and looks forward to our continued partnership in tackling health and wellness matters that affect the citizens of Prince George's County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that within six months there shall be further discussion and review of the information resulting from the FDA's research on the safety of electronic cigarettes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
Maryland, that if the FDA research is such that the County Council needs to enact legislation
with respect to electronic cigarettes to protect the citizens of Prince George's County, such
legislation shall advance through its Health, Education and Human Services Committee.
