BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

The Adopted Minor Public Facility Plan amendments for the MD 202 Corridor implement recommendations that were developed during the Route 202 Corridor Study. The study was completed in 1997 with the cooperation of citizens and development representatives. The Route 202 Planning Group recommended changes to three interchanges to reduce the amount of transportation infrastructure needed at specific locations coincident with a reduction of the cap on build-out in the study area. A Joint Public Hearing on the preliminary plan document was conducted by the District Council and the Planning Board on May 23, 2002 (PGCPB Resolution No. 02-99) and approved its transmittal to the District Council. At a Committee of the Whole worksession held on June 4, 2002 the Minor Public Facility Plan Amendments for the MD 202 Corridor received a favorable vote out of committee.
