**RESOLUTION**

A RESOLUTION concerning

Transfer of Merit Status Senior Aides to Limited Term Status Positions

FOR the purpose of complying with the National Council of Senior Citizens (NCSC) Senior Aides Training Program regulations regarding benefits for certain employees.

WHEREAS, the Federally funded Senior Aide Training and Employment Program, through the United States Department of

Labor NCSC Project, addresses program requirements, employment duration, benefits, and salary; and

WHEREAS, certain County employees are receiving benefits greater than those authorized under the Senior Aide Training Program; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County is the only worksite nationwide in which NCSC Program employees receive benefits greater than those authorized under the Senior Aides Training Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that upon the effective date of Council Bill 62, 1992, any classified service employee currently performing work characteristic of the Senior Aide class, as outlined within that legislation, shall be transferred to a limited term status position within the Senior Aide class of work and be entitled to only those benefits provided under the terms and conditions of the NCSC Senior Aides Project.
