### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

The Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement (DPIE) has the statutory responsibility to administer the waiver component of the universal design requirements. DPIE will assess an administrative fee to carry out its duties to ensure compliance with the universal design waiver requests. The administrative fee will be assessed at the time of building permit to comport with the exception to Section 813 of the Charter for Prince George's County.
