PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 3/30/00

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 4-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Wilson, Maloney, Russell and Scott.)

This bill will provide for modifications in the way retention points are calculated in the event of a reduction in force action by assessing greater weight to seniority and years of service. Also, this legislation contains the recommendation of the Seniority Task Force Report.

The legislation was amended to conform with the language in CB-22-2000.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of enacting CB-18-2000. However, there may be an impact when a reduction in force occurs.
