RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Contract Approvals

3 For approving a multi-year contract to procure Advance Life Support (ALS) Equipment,
4 Basic Life Support (BLS) Equipment, and maintenance for Prince George’s County, Maryland,
5 on behalf of the Prince George's County Fire/Emergency Medical Services Department

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George’s County, Maryland
7 the County Council must approve, by resolution, all multi-year contracts exceeding an aggregate
8 of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00); and

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George’s County, Maryland,
10 no agency of the County government shall, during any fiscal year, expend any money or incur
11 any liability in excess of the amounts appropriated and no such payment shall be made nor any
12 obligation or liability incurred, except for purchases in an amount to be fixed by legislative act;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Stryker Medical for ALS and
15 BLS Equipment and maintenance, and

16 WHEREAS, the contract between Prince George’s County, Maryland and Stryker Medical
17 will be conducted pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein as Attachment A.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
19 County, Maryland, that the agreement as described in Attachment A and pursuant to 819 of the
20 Prince George’s County Charter be and the same is hereby APPROVED.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make

1 any modification, adjustment, corrections, or any other changes as may be necessary to finalize
2 the contract in any manner the County Executive may deem necessary or proper, but not altering
3 its substance.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective as of the date of
5 its adoption.
