1 AN EMERGENCY ACT concerning

2 Supplementary Appropriations

3 For the purpose of appropriating to the General Fund revenue to provide for costs that were not
4 anticipated in the approved Fiscal Year 2000-2001 Budget.5 WHEREAS, CB-33-2000, as amended, adopted and enacted the Annual Budget and
6 Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 2000-2001, which set forth
7 the amount of appropriations and revenue estimates, said appropriation and revenue estimates to
8 be adjusted as hereinafter set forth; and9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland
10 the County Council may, upon recommendation of the County Executive, make additional or
11 supplementary appropriations from revenue received from anticipated sources but in excess of
12 budget estimates therefore, from revenue received from sources not anticipated in the budget for
13 the current year, and from any prior year available and uncommitted fund balance, provided that
14 the Director of Finance shall first certify in writing that such funds are available for such
15 appropriations; and16 WHEREAS, the additional appropriations as provided herein, and certain additional
17 revenue have been identified; and18 WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly recommended that the supplementary
19 appropriation be made; and20 WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified in writing that revenues are available for
21 such appropriation; now, therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the following adjustments to revenue estimates for Fiscal Year 2000-2001 for the General Fund, as expressed in CB-33-2000, as amended, are made:

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that supplementary appropriations are made as follows:

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that in accordance with the provisions of Section 317 of the Charter, the County Council hereby declares that a public emergency exists affecting the public health, safety, and welfare; said emergency being the need to provide funding to Dimensions Health Corporation in order to support the continuation of essential health services for the citizens of Prince George's County.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the day it becomes law and shall be retroactively effective to June 30, 2001.
