The Prince George's County Health, Human Services, and Public Safety Committee convened on Thursday, June 15, 2023, to consider appointments to the Commission for Veterans. The Commission serves to elevate, develop and promote new and existing programs and services for Veterans and their families here in Prince George's County.

Ms. Miriam Brewer, Liaison, Office of the County Executive, introduced the appointees; Mr. James Childs Jr, a resident of Capitol Heights and a Human Resource manager with 25 years of service in the army. Dr. Gerald D. George, a resident of Bowie who served in the Marines. Mr. Henry W. Harris, a resident of Fort Washington retired from the United States Air Force. Ms. Kimberly V. Lewis, Esq., is a resident of Clinton and a Special Counsel in the Maryland Office of the Attorney General and will serve as a public member. Mr. Darrell C. Odom. Sr. is a resident of Brandywine and served in the Army and United States Cost Guard and will serve as the Veterans of Foreign Wars representative. Ms. Ethel L. Sligh is a resident of Glenn Dale and spent three decades assisting veterans while employed by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. Ms. Lisa L.
