CB-044-2019 Swimming Pools

Legislative Summary

CB-044-2019 proposed by Council Chair Turner and presented on September 10, 2019 would allow safety standards for hotel and motel swimming pools with under 2,500 square feet of water surface area apply to sellers of health club services.

Background/Current Law

During the 2016 legislative session, the Prince George's County Council enacted CB-6-2016 to make the Prince George's County Code (the "Code") requirements consistent with State standards related to swimming pool supervision requirements for hotel and motel pools with a water surface area of under 2,500 square feet.

Assumptions and Methodology

CB-044-2019 will essentially extend the requirements imposed by CB-6-2016 to swimming pools with a water surface area of under 2,500 square feet located within or outside a building *registered as a seller of health club services*. Safety requirements for these pools will then be in accordance with State regulations, including COMAR 10.17.01.40F, and Code Section 5-224.

Fiscal Impact
