BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The purpose of this bill is to address the public health and safety effects of the over-concentration of convenience stores in areas of Prince George's County by setting a minimum distance on the placement of new convenience stores from existing stores. In addition, the bill sets new hours of

operations for convenience stores by requiring all such stores to close at 10pm.
