This resolution will establish a twelve member Task Force on Seniority to review the County Personnel Code and recommend appropriate amendments to the County Council and County Executive within 45 days from the date of adoption.

The resolution was amended extending the reporting date to 60 days and adding the Alternate Trustee of the General Schedule Supplemental Pension Plan as a member of the Task Force.
