BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Board of Registration for Building Contractors

3 For the purpose of amending the provisions of the County Code relating to the Board of
 4 Registration for Building Contractors.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

7 Section 2-253.08,

8 The Prince George's County Code

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 11 Maryland, that Section 2-253.08 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
 12 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 **SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.**

14 **DIVISION 14A. BUILDING CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE.**

15 **Sec. 2-253.08. Board of Registration.**

16 (a) A board of registration for building contractors is hereby created. The board shall
 17 consist of [five (5)] seven (7) members, all of whom shall be appointed by the County Executive
 18 subject to Council confirmation pursuant to the Charter. Three (3) members of the board shall be
 19 members of a recognized association of home builders [and the other two (2)] . Three (3)
 20 members shall not have an active interest in the building and construction field. One member
 21 shall be a representative of the County Council. At least four (4) of the appointments, including

the three (3) non-industry members and the Council representative, shall be selected from a list of persons submitted by the County Council.

* * * * *

(d) The board shall elect from its members a chairman, vice chairman and secretary. [The chairman shall be selected by the Executive subject to Council confirmation pursuant to the Charter.] The chairman shall be selected from among the members without an active interest in the building and construction field. In exercising its powers and duties under this Division, not less than [three (3)] four (4) members shall constitute a quorum. The board shall keep minutes of its proceedings and meetings. All decisions of the board shall be in written form with findings. For assistance in reaching decisions, the board may request technical assistance, advice, data, or factual evidence from the County or other governmental agency. The board shall submit to the Executive an annual report of its proceedings.

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SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
