BILL

AN ACT concerning

Correctional Officers' Pension Plan

For the purpose of providing that disability benefit payments made to certain employees of the Prince George's County Department of Corrections pursuant to the Pension Plan for employees represented by the Prince George's Correctional Officers' Association, Inc. shall be considered in the nature of workers' compensation payments made pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

Section 16-232,

The Prince George's County Code

(1995 Edition).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 16-232 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 16. PERSONNEL.

DIVISION 18. PENSIONS GENERALLY.

Sec. 16-232. Disability payments for public safety employees.

Any payments made to uniformed employees occupying classified service positions allocated to public safety classes of work within the Police, Fire [or], Sheriff or Corrections

Departments for injuries received in the line of duty pursuant to the provisions of any retirement disability provisions of any pension plan established under Section 16-231 shall be considered in the nature of [workmen's] workers' compensation payments made pursuant to Title 9 of the Maryland Labor and Employment Code Annotated.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
