RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Prince George's Intergovernmental Network Community Coordinating Committee

3 For the purpose of designating the Prince George's Intergovernmental Network

4 Community Coordinating Committee as the entity to manage the institutional network.

5 WHEREAS, the cable television franchise agreement that was negotiated by the

6 County and the 17 participating municipalities provided for the payment of certain

7 franchise fees to fund the construction of a dedicated fiber optic institutional network to

8 connect public facilities throughout the County; and

9 WHEREAS, the institutional network has been constructed with approximately 184

10 sites with the capacity for high speed voice, video, and data transfer on a dedicated safe

11 and secure network; and

12 WHEREAS, representatives of the 17 participating municipalities and the County

13 have been overseeing the design, construction and operation of the institutional network,

14 have organized the Prince George's Intergovernmental Network Community

15 Coordinating Committee; and

16 WHEREAS, Section 5A-108 of the County Code provides for the designation of

17 one or more entities to manage any necessary scheduling or allocation of capacity on the

18 institutional network; and

19 WHEREAS, the Prince George's Intergovernmental Network Community

20 Coordinating Committee seeks designation pursuant to Section 5A-108 as the entity

21 responsible for the management of the institutional network; and

22 WHEREAS, the cable franchise agreement effective June 14, 1999, designated the

1 Community Coordinating Committee as the agent for Prince George's County, Maryland
2 for the purposes of managing and paying for construction of the I-Net System Upgrade.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Intergovernmental Network
4 Community Coordinating Committee shall submit its bylaws to the County for approval
5 no later than February 28, 2005.
