Preparation of a new Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) and approval of goals,		
concepts, guideli	nes, and public participation program for the Landover Metro area, which is a	
portion of Planni	ng Areas 69 and 72.	
For the purpose of initiating an amendment to the 1994 Approved Master Plan and Sectional		
Map Amendment	for Bladensburg-New Carrollton and Vicinity (Planning Area 69) and building	
upon the 2010 Su	abregion 4 Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (Planning Area 72), the	
2005 Countywide	e Green Infrastructure Functional Master Plan, the 2008 Approved Public	
Facilities Master	Plan, and the 2009 Master Plan of Transportation; and approving the goals,	
concepts, guidelines, and public participation program in order to develop a comprehensive		
approach to build	upon the recommendations of the	
2002 Prince George's County Approved General Plan, and to ensure that future development is		
consistent with co	ounty policies.	
WHEREAS	, the current master plan and sectional map amendment (SMA) for Bladensburg	
-New Carrollton	and Vicinity (Planning Area 69) was approved in May 1994 and the Subregion	
4 Master Plan (Pl	anning Area 72) was approved in June 2010; and	
WHEREAS	, Sections 27-225.01.05 and 27-641 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince	
George's County establish procedures whereby the Prince George's County Planning Board ma		
nitiate a sector plan and a concurrent SMA with the approval or concurrence of the District		
Council; and		

WHEREAS, the approved Fiscal Year 2012 Planning Department Work Program includes

the preparation of the Landover Metro Area and MD 202 Corridor Sector Plan and SMA to evaluate the land uses, plan elements, and recommendations contained in the 1994 Approved Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment for Bladensburg-New Carrollton and Vicinity (Planning Area 69) and build upon the recommendations of the 2010 Approved Subregion 4 Master Plan and Sectional Map Amendment (Planning Area 72), and to implement the 2002 General Plan's recommendations for tiers, growth centers, and designated corridor nodes within these planning areas, the 2005 Countywide Green Infrastructure Plan and the 2009 Approved Countywide Master Plan of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the sector plan area is focused on the MD 202 corridor right-of-way from slightly west of the Baltimore-Washington Parkway to Barlowe Road and the commercial, institutional, and multifamily properties along that portion of the corridor as shown in the attached Sector Plan boundary map; and

WHEREAS, the goals, concepts, guidelines, and public participation program (Attachment A) establish the purpose, the preliminary range of issues to be addressed during the plan preparation, and THE basic methodology for ensuring adequate community involvement throughout the planning process; and

WHEREAS, the sector plan will set development policies and guidelines to provide a mix of uses at an intensity appropriate for land within the Developed Tier, as articulated in the 2002 *Prince George's County Approved General Plan*; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the District Council to process the sector plan and sectional map amendment concurrently, in accordance with Section 27-225.01.05 of the Zoning Ordinance, to shorten the process and provide a strong interrelationship between the sector plan and zoning of land as a tool to implement land use recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a sector plan and concurrent sectional map amendment (SMA) for the Landover Metro Area and MD 202 Corridor in accordance with the requirements of Parts 3 and 13 of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Council has considered and hereby approves the goals, concepts, guidelines, and public participation program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this	s Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
