	Adequate Public Safety Facilities Surcharge	
For the purpose of	of approving a waiver of the adequate public safety facilities surcharge for all	
residential units	within the "Leroy Petry Village of Honor" Project.	
WHEREAS	s, in Council Bill 89-2004, the County Council of Prince George's County and	
the County Exec	utive enacted an amendment to Section 24-122.01 of the Subdivision	
Regulations, to in	mpose an adequate public safety surcharge for new residential construction in	
the County; and		
WHEREAS	s, consistent with the requirements of Chapter 594 of the Laws of Maryland of	
2005 (House Bill	1129), codified as Section 10-192.11 of the Prince George's County Code, the	
Council and Exe	cutive approved Council Bill 56-2005, to modify the requirements of CB-89-	
2004; and		
WHEREAS	S, as modified, Section 24-122.01 of the Subdivision Regulations requires	
certain public saf	fety information and findings, at the time of application for approval of a	
preliminary plan	of subdivision; and	
WHEREAS	S, Section 24-122.01 (e) (4) authorizes the County Council and County	
Executive, acting as the governing body of Prince George's County, to waive any surcharge		
imposed within t	he County's Developed Tier, as designated in the 2002 General Plan; and	
WHEREAS	s, the "Leroy Petry Village of Honor" Project ("Project") of Danner	
Development ("Danner"), as approved by the Planning Board in PGCPB No (Final Plat)		
includes approxi	mately 1.53 acres of land in the R-R zone, located on the east side of 47 <sup>th</sup>	
Avenue, 300 feet	south of its intersection with Longfellow Street; and	

WHEREAS, the subject property was undeveloped and sold by Danner; and WHEREAS, the "Leroy Petry Village of Honor" Project received preliminary plan and final plat approval for 7 lots; and

WHEREAS, the "Leroy Petry Village of Honor" Project represents an opportunity to provide housing at no cost to wounded warriors and their families in Prince George's County, which has the highest number of veterans in the State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, the "Leroy Petry Village of Honor" Project represents Danner's vision to provide housing for our veterans by buying and donating the land and partnering with Troops First to construct the seven homes and furnish them in honor of two heroes, Leroy Petry, a Congressional Medal of Honor winner, and Chief Kyle Court; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has determined, because of the importance of the need to provide housing for our wounded veterans and their families as they recover in particular, and because the Project will have many positive effects on the residential and community environment, that the public safety facilities surcharge required in CB-55-2005 and in CB-56-2005 should be waived, and that building permits may be issued for the project without the imposition of the surcharge; and

WHEREAS, the Council has further determined that the public safety facilities surcharge should be waived because the area of the subject property is and will for the foreseeable future be more than adequately served by the existing school, police and fire facilities; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution will be transmitted to the County Executive for his approval, to complete the process required for the waiver of the public safety facilities surcharge for the "Leroy Petry Village of Honor" Project property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the public facilities surcharge required in CB-55-2005 and in CB-56-2005 is hereby waived, for the property included in the "Leroy Petry Village of Honor" Project, and building permits may be issued for the dwelling units, without payment of the surcharge.
